

Searching for module descriptions – A guide for all campo roles

Searching for module descriptions

In some cases, you have to call up module descriptions when making changes to a degree program. This may be the case if new modules are to be added that have not (yet) been assigned to a degree program or when editing the accreditation of modules.

When looking for modules, campo offers the function **“Search in module handbooks”**, which can be accessed via “Degree programs” > “Module descriptions”.

This takes you to a search screen where you can use various criteria to search for modules or their module description:
